1. Judging Categories

2. Types of Events

Events are classified as YouTube based and Photo based. Details of each event type are provided in the 'Events in Detail' section (Third page below each event name).

3. How to Submit Entries

- a) Individual Participants: Submit entries via WhatsApp chat.
- Schools/Institutes: Contact via WhatsApp/Email to receive the registration process.
- Upon submission of entries and fees, an entry number will be issued within a few working days.
- d) Only after receiving the entry number, participants can proceed with recording videos and creating content.

4. Registration Fees

The registration fee per entry is as follows:

- a) INR 360 Till 31 July 2025
- b) INR 390 From 1 August 2025 to 15 September 2025
- c) INR 430 From 16 September 2025 to 15 October 2025
- d) INR 490 With late fees, from 16 October to 15 November 2025
- e) Fees for overseas students remain the same.
- f) Overseas students will receive only an e-certificate. For a memento and hard copy of the certificate, additional courier charges apply.
- g) Schools may charge an additional administrative fee (maximum 20%) if they handle registration and related processes on behalf of parents.

5. Prize Distribution

- a) Certificates and Mementos (4x6 inches, Wooden/Glass Material) will be delivered to the respective
 Parent/School/Institute within 60-90 days from the result announcement.
- b) If a certificate or memento is damaged during transit, the Parent/School/Institute must return it for replacement.

6. Photo-Based Event Guidelines

- e) Do not use apps to record videos.

- h) Assistance for uploading videos on YouTube will not be provided.
- Voiceovers are strictly not allowed in any video submissions for singing, dance, speech, or any other contest categories.

- j) In the case of Sanskrit shlokas, no explanation, translation, or interpretation should be included in the video.
- k) Parents or guardians may announce the participant's name and basic details from behind the camera at the beginning of the video; however, this announcement must be done live and not as a voiceover.

8. Recording & Technical Guidelines

- a) Record videos indoors in a fixed-frame mode.
- Participants should perform in a seated or standing position, except for Dance, Stylish Kid, and Fancy Dress events.
- c) Video should be in horizontal format.
- d) Performances must be solo; no guidance via teleprompters, headphones, or other equipment is allowed.
- No special effects, digital graphics, titles, or animations are permitted.
- f) Videos must be recorded in a single take, without editing.

9. Submission Guidelines

- a) YouTube links & Photos (JPG format) must be submitted only via Google Form provided after registration.
- b) Submissions via Google Drive, Email, or other platforms will not be accepted.
- Schools/Institutes must enter the YouTube link in the same Excel file in which entry numbers were assigned.
- d) Videos submitted for other events will **not be accepted.**
- e) Participants must provide a valid WhatsApp number for communication.

- The judges' decisions are final. No queries regarding judgment will be entertained.
- b) Only overall participation numbers and the total number of schools will be shared. Category-wise participant details and judges' names will not be disclosed.
