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


# From the Director's Desk

We as a school team and you as a parental team are there as a coordination team for ever upward journey in this challenging world for our little young challengers.



## 21st June - International Yoga Day



### Day 3: Sports Day



Cultural Day was a vibrant showcase of traditional dances and customs. Students performed various dances, celebrating the diversity of India's culture.



On the fifth day, sustainability took center stage with eco-friendly activities. An exhibition promoted cooking without fire, encouraging healthier and more sustainable practices.







## Gratitude Note Making




## Elocution


Each staff member received a "Mental Health Day" card along with a self-care checklist to track daily self-care activities for a week. This initiative aimed to promote self-care practices among all staff.

Congratulations once again to you, the staff, the parents, and most importantly, the children for making December 10th a day to cherish forever.





